News From Our Friends, League of Women Voters of St. Cloud Area In December/January, your Board voted unanimously to fund the 2024 Paramount Center for the Arts Festival with a \$1,000 sponsorship grant, and two \$250 student awards. We also voted to allocate funding for the Flash Funds programs which had utilized funds during the 2023 calendar year, as follows: Flash Funds for Minority Women – SCSU \$500.00 Flash Funds for Minority Women – CSB \$400.00

Your Board unanimously voted to refrain from NCCWSL participation in 2024, and form a committee to investigate participation in 2025. While we are supportive of the program we do not have volunteers to manage our participation.

Your Board voted and approved a \$125.00 donation in support of the D-Blake Center Eight Grade Graduation event, to be held at SCSU on June 8, 2024. We are so pleased to be able to help again this year with this event.

Our Finance Chair Barb Wismer has devised a way to track all our expenses, from initial request through to showing the source of funds. This was a request from the State organization, to begin such tracking and to improve our audit trails.

We remain in great need of volunteers to work with our existing Board members, and take over those positions when this fiscal year ends on June 30, 2024. We are forming an Executive Search Committee, but if your skills and talents can be applied to assist our Branch in any way, please contact us. We'd really like to get new Board members trained but will, of course, be available to answer any questions or concerns.






